



Minutes of the Owasippe Staff Association 40th Annual Meeting & Dinner Dance

Celebrating 40 years of service and fellowship.

Chauncey Niziol welcomed everyone to the 40th Anniversary of the OSA. He thanked the present PTAC council and all OSA members for helping Owasippe maintain operations for years to come. The annual meeting was called to order at 8:20 p.m. by OSA President Kurt Wolff-Klammer. A quorum of the board was present to conduct business. Kurt welcomed everyone and thanked all for coming.

The minutes of the 2017 annual meeting were presented, and a motion to accept them was made, seconded, and approved by acclamation. The OSA Board presented the annual financial report for 2017. Kurt highlighted the donation in honor of Erv Brinkman from the John Grout estate. A motion was made to accept the report, and it was seconded by Chauncey Niziol and carried by acclamation.

He also thanked the spouses of board members for the time they commit so their spouses can serve on the board and get the many tasks completed. Elections chair Dan Kleinfeldt thanked the many candidates of this election before announcing the three winners as Greg Lange, Rachel Weber, and Bob Kurth. He then announced the officer positions: Kyle Nystrom as president, Scott Dorencz as vice president, Kurt Wolff-Klammer as treasurer, and Barb Lea as secretary.

Kyle thanked Dan for serving 12 years as elections chairperson. Kyle finalized the meeting, thanking all for their attendance at the Annual Meeting and Dinner Dance.
