





## **Minutes of the Owasippe Staff Association 41st Annual Meeting & Dinner Dance**

Celebrating 41 years of service and fellowship.

Kyle Nystrom welcomed everyone to the 41st anniversary of the OSA and thanked everyone for being present at the annual meeting. He thanked the all OSA members for helping Owasippe maintain operations for years to come. The annual meeting was called to order at 8:35 p.m. by OSA President Kyle Nystrom. A quorum of the board was present to conduct business.

The minutes of the 2018 annual meeting were presented, and a motion to accept them was made, seconded, and approved by acclamation. The OSA Board presented the annual financial report for 2018. Kyle highlighted the recent OSA donation to replace the entire building for the Blackhawk Staff Kybo and showerhouse. More donations toward that project are needed and welcomed. A motion was made to accept the report, and it was seconded and then carried by acclamation.

Doug Lotter presented the membership report and then handed out Life Member plaques to those who had committed to the Life Membership level. Membership stands at 373 members, 228 of which are Life Members. Kyle directed attendees to the page in the program with special recognitions of select members and then asked for a moment of silence to remember those who passed away in the past year.

Kyle called to the stage Barb Lea to honor the Member of the Year for 2018: Pete Kulak. Pete has edited Vibrations, the OSA's quarterly newsletter, for at least seven years. He ensures that the newsletters are delivered in the new technology-based format while still balancing accuracy, clarity, and completeness of all content. He gathers news, spreads announcements, and includes news items both serious and lighthearted. He has shown a long-time commitment to the OSA, and the newsletter management is just the current method of that involvement. Pete thanked the board for the recognition and all of the previous editors of the Vibrations for establishing a strong format. He encouraged every member to send in material to include!

Scott Dorencz then recognized those who had completed their first year on the board and thanked the outgoing board members: Barb Lea, Kurt Wolff-Klammer, and Kyle Nystrom, all of whom held key roles in leadership for the executive board. Elections chair Dan Kleinfeldt first thanked the members of the OSA for the many kind words shared with the Kleinfeldt after the passing of his father, Wally Kleinfeldt. He then thanked the many candidates of this election before announcing the three winners as Candy Merritt, Kevin Harper, and Adam Keene. He then announced the officer positions: Scott Dorencz as president, Candy Merritt as vice president, Doug Lotter as treasurer, and Rachel Weber as secretary.

Scott thanked Dan for serving 13 years as elections chairperson. Scott finalized the meeting, thanking all for their attendance at the Annual Meeting and Dinner Dance and asking for similar attendance at events like the Fix-It weekends, Family Picnic, and other social gatherings. He asked if there was any remaining business to conduct that it be presented to individual board members throughout the night. After a few closing announcements about the raffles, silent auction, and memorabilia sales, Scott asked for a motion to close the meeting. That motion was made by an audience member, seconded without discussion, and the motion was carried by acclamation at 8:50 p.m.
