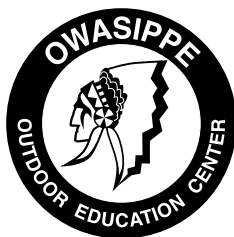

Thank you and farewell.

In 2003 a group of dedicated individuals formed the Owasippe Outdoor Education Center to protect the Owasippe Scout Reservation, America's oldest continuously operating Boy Scout camp, from sale to developers. Since that time, our Board of Directors has been a voice for expanded use of the 4,800-acre property. We are pleased that the main purpose of the organization's creation has been accomplished.

It is with a mix of emotions that the Owasippe Outdoor Education Center announces the planned dissolution of the nonprofit organization, effective June 30, 2021. The board of directors voted recently to cease operations as of December 31, 2020 and take the steps to formally close the nonprofit. All remaining assets of the OOEC, both financial and of property, will be distributed to the Owasippe Staff Association, a 501(c)3 organization that shares our love of the Owasippe Scout Reservation and a dedication to environmentally conscious improvements to the camp. The OSA has a 43-year track record of responsible use of donor funds and will be able to maintain all donations made to OOEC for earmarked uses.

The Board of Directors of the OOEC would like to express our gratitude for our many supporters and donors over our 17 years of operation. Our mission has been completed, and our directors look forward to continuing our personal service to Owasippe in our own unique ways.

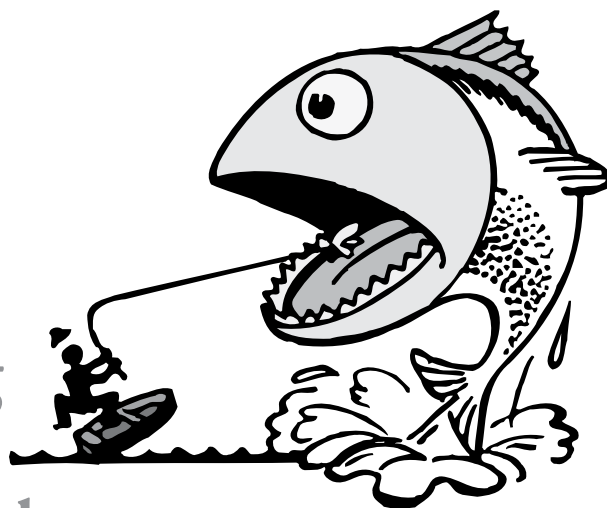

Minutes of the Owasippe Staff Association 42nd Annual Meeting & Dinner Dance

Celebrating 42 years of service and fellowship.

Scott Dorencz welcomed everyone to the 42nd anniversary of the OSA and thanked everyone for being present at the annual meeting. He thanked all OSA members for helping Owasippe maintain operations for years to come. The annual meeting was called to order at 8:17 p.m. by OSA President Scott Dorencz. A quorum of the board was present to conduct business.

The minutes of the 2019 annual meeting were presented, and a motion to accept them was made by Rachel Weber, seconded by Andy Sirota, and approved by acclamation. The OSA Treasurer Doug Lotter presented the annual financial report for 2019. Doug highlighted the recent OSA donation to replace the entire building for the Blackhawk Staff Kybo and showerhouse. He stated that the organization is in excellent financial shape. A motion was made to accept the report by Kurt Wolff-Klammer, and it was seconded by Anthony Marzano and then carried by acclamation.

Adam Keene presented the membership report and then handed out Life Member plaques to those who had committed to the Life Membership level. Membership stands at 453 members, 231 of which are Life Members. Candy Merritt directed attendees to the page in the program with special recognitions of select members and then asked for a moment of silence to remember those who passed away in the past year.

Candy then recognized those who had completed their first year on the board and thanked the outgoing board members: Scott Dorencz, Doug Lotter, and Carl Young. Candy highlighted some ways for members to become more involved in the operation of the OSA, including a new fundraising committee that is looking for 5-8 people to help initiate new ideas and the opportunity to help run events such as the White Sox game or the Family Picnic. She also thanked the Derby and Wolff-Klammer families for their help in preparing for the Dinner Dance. Elections chair Dan Kleinfeldt echoed Candy's suggested ways to increase involvement, adding that all members are welcome to nominate others or to run for a board position. He then thanked the many candidates of this election before announcing the three winners as Michelle O'Connor, Henry Nakazawa, and Jennifer Kotwasinski. He then announced the officer positions: Kevin Harper as president, Rachel Weber as vice president, Adam Keene as treasurer, and Jen Kotwasinski as secretary.

Scott turned the official OSA president gavel over to Kevin Harper. Kevin finalized the meeting, thanking all for their attendance at the Annual Meeting and Dinner Dance and asking for similar attendance at events like the Fix-It weekends, White Sox Game, Family Picnic, and other social gatherings. He in particular welcomed everyone to attend OSA Board meetings – either in person or virtually. He requested that any remaining business to conduct that it be presented to individual board members throughout the night. After a few closing announcements about the raffles, silent auction, and memorabilia sales, Kevin closed the meeting portion of the evening at 8:40 p.m.
