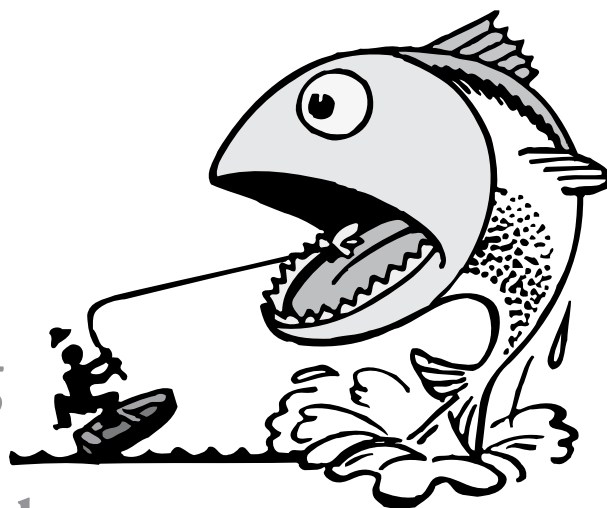

Minutes of the Owasippe Staff Association 44th Annual Meeting & Dinner Dance

Presented by Susan Derby, OSA Life Member

March 5, 2022

Via Zoom with breakout rooms

Celebrating 44 years of service and fellowship.

Kevin Harper welcomed everyone to the 44th anniversary of the OSA and thanked everyone for being present at the annual meeting. He thanked all OSA members for being flexible in having the meeting online due to ongoing Covid concerns. The annual meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by OSA President Kevin Harper. A quorum of the board was present to conduct business.

The minutes of the 2021 annual meeting were presented and reviewed, and a motion to accept them was made by Edgar Wolff-Klammer, seconded by Michelle O'Connor, and approved by acclamation. The OSA Treasurer Adam Keene presented the annual financial report for 2021. He stated that the organization is in strong financial shape and highlighted some particular values in the financial report. Of special note was the Steve Shafer Fund, currently at \$9,000 thanks to multiple donors. Despite recent challenges in investment accounts, the organization manages over \$325,000 in assets. A motion was made to accept the report by Carl Young, and it was seconded by Bill Vannerson and then carried by acclamation. Kevin then directed attendees to the Special Recognitions section of the virtual program. He directed attendees to another part of the program and requested a moment of silence for those who were lost this year.

Kevin thanked the outgoing board members and the candidates of this year's election. Elections had been conducted in the days leading up to the annual meeting, with final votes in just before the meeting was called to order. Board seats were duly elected to Candy Merritt, Kevin Harper, and Ron Kulak. Kevin then announced the officer positions: Kevin Harper as president, Chris Sanchez as vice president, Ron Kulak as treasurer, and Jen Kotwasinski as secretary.

Kevin Harper acknowledged the difficulties that the past year has brought, with Covid pandemic shutdowns and limitations, but he also mentioned good that has come of it including increased volunteer service and increased contacts with past camp friends. He celebrated the steps that show a return to normal events and projects for the OSA as restrictions are lifted. The Spring Fix-It is scheduled to operate as it traditionally has - with some much-needed projects around camp, in particular to improve and expand housing for summer camp staff.

Kevin opened the floor with a call for new business, of which none was brought forth. He noted that over \$4,000 in raffle tickets had already been sold for this evening and noted that drawings would happen at 7:30, after which the breakout rooms would be open for members to meet in small groups until 9 p.m. He requested that any remaining business be presented to individual board members throughout the night in those smaller virtual rooms. He made some final recognitions of those who were key in planning the evening, organizing the raffles, conducting the elections, and creating the program. Kevin closed the meeting portion of the evening at 7:18 p.m. with a motion by Carl Young and seconded by Ron Kulak.
