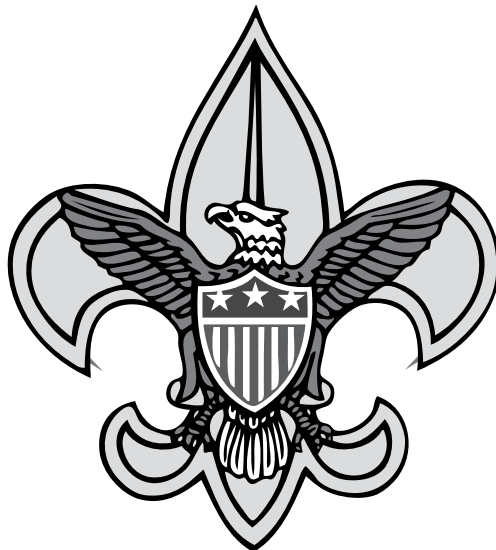

## Minutes of the Owasippe Staff Association 46th Annual Meeting & Dinner Dance

*Presented by Susan Derby, OSA Life Member*

March 9, 2024

Allegra Banquets in Villa Park, IL

Kevin Harper welcomed everyone to the 46th anniversary of the OSA and thanked everyone for being present at the annual meeting. The annual meeting was called to order at 7:18 p.m. by OSA President Kevin Harper. A quorum of the board was present to conduct business.

The minutes of the 2023 annual meeting were presented and reviewed, and a motion to accept them was made by Pat Troy, seconded by Wally Kleinfeldt, and approved by acclamation. OSA Treasurer Edgar Wolff-Klammer presented the annual financial report for 2023. He highlighted \$402,263 in assets and steered members to the full financial report in the ad book program. Edgar celebrated a \$50,000 donation in December from a single OSA member. Edgar thanked the Schlichtings for donating lunches at their hops farm and Hot Pot lunch spot for all Fix-It volunteers. He finalized his report by encouraging all members to invite an Owasippe friend, fellow staffer, or camper to join the OSA. A motion was made to accept the report by Karl Young, and it was seconded by Pat Troy and then carried by acclamation.

Kevin returned to the podium and directed attendees to the Special Recognitions section of the ad book. He summarized the membership report, showing 355 members overall, of which 248 are life members. Only 39 people still owe dues in order to be current, which is a large improvement over this time last year. Kevin gave Life Member plaques to Tom Sniegowski and Jeff Nowik, who were both present. He then called up Mike Mieszczak and awarded him the Member of the Year award for 2023. Mike ran the Trade-o-Ree and was present at the fix-its. After that recognition, Kevin thanked those who also went above and beyond at fix-its such as Brian Kempa and his roofing crew, Gary Dorencz for heading up 2 staff village cabins and now 2 cook cabin rehabs, plus other work like drainage at LC 6, rehabbing LC 5, and new curtains for Reneker B-side cabins. 2023 saw almost \$29,000 in materials for camp improvement and hundreds of hours of labor.

Kevin introduced Dan Kleinfeldt, elections chairperson. Dan thanked the outgoing board members for stepping up to manage the organization and giving back to the camp. He also thanked the candidates of this year's election. Board seats were duly elected to Kevin Oster, Chris Sanchez, Paul Kerchberger, and Mike Brus (filling a 1-year seat opened by Eddie McCarthy stepping down). Dan then announced the officer positions: Jen Kotwasinski as president, Chris Sanchez as vice president, Edgar Wolff-Klammer as treasurer, and Paul Kerchberger as secretary.

Kevin opened the floor with a call for new business, at which time three items were brought: Chauncey Niziol requested the use of Grey Staff Village cabins for aging OSA members during fix-its, Chris Sanchez requested that everyone mark the fix-it dates in their calendars and attend in an effort to reach 100 workers each weekend, and Scott Dorencz who thanked Kevin Harper for running the OSA eBay store and sharing Owasippe merchandise with the online shopping opportunities. Kevin reminded attendees of upcoming raffles that are still open for ticket purchases. Kevin closed the meeting portion of the evening at 7:34 p.m. with a motion by Bill Lotter and seconded by Kevin Oster.
